






THE SHADE TREE A'S - THIRTY YEARS AGO

The cover of the April 1988 issue of the Shade Tree A's Newsletter touted the benefits of the American Austin and Bantam by proclaiming that "Good Things Did Come In Small Packages". The law of the month was "The least accessable [sic] nut or bolt will always be stripped or frozen". Safety tips for using a circular grinder or sander were also provided.
