



## **Carpenter Bees Cause Damage**

Carpenter bees can be a problem. They chew the wood making holes and damage wood structures. A natural way to keep them away from your wooden buildings is to make fake Hornet nests out of garbage bags and hang them. Hornets eat carpenter bees, so they stay away from them for their safety. If you have bees try using a couple "fake" hornet nests for a solution.



## Moth Damage in Closed Car Model A

If you own a closed car Model A long enough you will probably experience moth damage to your upholstery. Moths love wool and most of our cars have wool interiors. To help prevent damage to your car I have two suggestions. You can purchase a couple pounds of dry ice and place in the floor boards with the windows rolled up. The dry ice will give off carbon dioxide gas as it melts and will kill all moths and their larvae. Once a month application will keep them away. Also placing moth balls under the rear seat will help as well. Happy motoring to all!




