

For starters, a little history of the Model A Foundation, Inc. In 1984, trustees of the Model A Ford Club of America (MAFCA) began to discuss formation of a foundation with tax-exempt, charitable status. By 1987, a separate organization, MAFFI was officially recognized, with the goal of building a museum dedicated to the preservation of the Model A Ford car and related items of the era. The foundation grew and developed plans to build, and finally settled on the Gilmore location. The current building was completed in the fall of 2012, and the Grand opening was held in May, 2013.

Membership has steadily grown, and MAFFI has not had an increase in dues since well before the Museum existed. However, the cost of operating the Museum has continued to rise. The MAFFI Board of Trustees, in careful consideration of all the facts, has voted to implement the following dues structure, **effective May 1, 2023**. Note that <u>each membership includes the named member and spouse/domestic partner</u>.

Annual Dues - \$35 3 year membership - \$100 Lifetime Membership - \$500

Please note that MAFFI is the only partner museum at the Gilmore that offers a Lifetime membership, and... we maintain the lowest annual dues on the campus. 
St. Patrick's Day Parade


THE SHADE TREE A'S - THIRTY YEARS AGO



The 1985-2005 Shade Tree A's Newsletters are now available on the Shade Tree A's website. They can be accessed via the same "button" as the other Newsletters, but they are password protected. The same password used to access the member roster is used to access the Newsletters. Thank you Dan Perla for scanning these and posting on the website.

In the April 1993 issue of the *Shade Tree A's Newsletter*, the President's Column discussed the Shade Tree A's potential involvement in the formation of a Southern Region of the Model A Ford Club of America. The *Newsletter* also included an article written by Marianne Blancarte of LeBaron Bonney (Remember them?) on *Keeping It Clean - Preserving Your Upholstery's Like-New Look*.

The report on the Richmond Hill tour described a tour in which eight all-weather drivers in eight allweather Model A's encountered white caps in the pool, flying shingles, snow coming down sideways, and an overturned semi truck. A Category II hurricane and 74 mph winds forced outdoor events into enclosed buildings. Garages were even arranged to house the cars if needed. Unfortunately, one car sustained body damage from flying debris. Elsewhere in the *Newsletter* it was

TECHNICAL TOPICS

Heat Source for Loosening Stuck Fasteners

The test used a bolt and threaded plate setup with a fixed weight and lever to apply a consistent, repeatable torque to the test fastener. The heat sources evaluated were:

- MAP-Pro torch
- Propane torch
- Butane kitchen torch
- Heat gun
- Oxyacetylene torch

The winner was the method that loosened the test setup in the shortest time. As might be expected the winner was the oxyacetylene torch. The complete results are shown in the table below. Comments on the article suggested another heat source, induction heating, that would minimize heat transfer to other surrounding components. One commenter suggested the Mini-Ductor II Handheld Induction Heater by Induction Innovations, available on Amazon for \$450. Another method I have heard of is a TIG torch but none of the commenters mentioned that.









